CREATIVE WRITING IDEAS:

- ◆ What Can You Do to Take Care of the Earth

- ◆ Why do you think He created the things in the order He did? Did He have a reason or what?

- ◆ What if God hadn't made water? Sun? Trees? Etc. How would the world be different?
- ◆ Read The Parable of The Rich Fool (Luke 12:13-21). What else could he have done with his excess goods?
